First of all I would like to thank George Cubiss and Anne Jackson for their support and participation in putting on the Skips and Thirds clinics. The clinics would not happen without their help.

This year we made some small changes to the program incorporating more strategy content. We also put our presentation on power point. This makes it easier for the participants to see, and replaces our dog eared flip chart paper. This requires that we use a projector. Fortunately Anne has a projector that we could use. We travelled to 7 clubs this year, twice to West Van who had too many for one session. We like the session to have no more than 16 people, any more and logistics become a problem.
